Wales Community Voice Programme Outcomes:

Three short term

1. A greater number of citizens are able to influence policy and decisions about services in their community.
2. Communities and service providers work together to design and deliver improved services.
3. Communities have an increased capacity to conceive and deliver better services and projects.



Wales Community Voice Programme Outcomes:

Two long term

1. Improved engagement and participation in the community.
2. Citizens report improved delivery of services, which meet their needs more effectively.

1. Mechanisms are established to ensure communities have a means to have their voices recognised, heard and listened to on an equal basis as service providers and public bodies
